
Jessie Exline – Maintenance Technician

Have Your Ducts Inspected

Duct Repair or Replacement Will Save You Money and Enhance Your Comfort

Heating, ventilation, and air conditioning equipment distributes air throughout a house by an important system known as "duct work." Ducts are typically located in the attic, under the house, or hidden behind the sheetrock walls. This vital system intricately woven throughout the home delivers the air into each room. The duct system acts as the "lungs" of a home. "Return" ducts bring room temperature air into the system and "supply" ducts deliver cool or warm air into each room. When

this system is properly designed, air distribution is even and a uniform temperature is maintained. Any break, tear, kink or leak in the ductwork robs your system of money, comfort, and healthy indoor air.

Leaking ducts can cause energy bills to rise and system capacities to be reduced.

Leaking ducts are also are a source of unbalanced temperatures throughout a house. Return-air duct leakage can cause dirty coils, thus




reducing capacity. Return-duct leakage is also blamed for increased humidity levels in a house and allows contaminants to enter. It is also blamed for return duct leakage in a house and allows contaminants to enter the air stream of a living space.

The objectives of good duct work design are comfort, proper air distribution, efficient cooling and heating, and an economical duct installation. Having new ductwork installed to replace old inefficient ducting can do as much or more to benefit your home as having insulation blown in or new windows installed. It is equally important that new ducts be

installed properly for the correct airflow and correct system performance.

If you are considering having a new system installed, consider also having the old ductwork replaced. After all, why have a super, high efficiency system installed without replacing old ductwork from 1982? Similarly, if you have the engine rebuilt in your favorite car, you certainly wouldn't reuse the old oil pump, would you? Probably not. The results would definitely be inefficient and could be disastrous.

Most homes built prior to the early 1990s have inefficient ductwork. We see the most inefficient ductwork in homes built prior to the 1970s primarily

CREATIVE COOKING Mississippi Mud Cake

A Favorite Sweet Treat from Benson Green's Childhood.

Cake Ingredients:

2 cups sugar1 cup shortening4 large eggs, slightly beaten1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour1/3 cup cocoa powder

1/4 teaspoon salt3 teaspoons vanilla extract1 cup chopped nuts1/2 of 10 oz package of mini marshmallows

Directions

Preheat oven to 300 degrees. Grease and flour oblong pan. Cream sugar and shortening. Add eggs one at a time, beating by hand. Sift flour, cocoa and salt into a separate bowl. Gradually add, mix well and then add vanilla and nuts. Pour into prepared pan. Bake for 35 minutes. Remove from oven and pour marshmallows over top and return to oven for 10 minutes and bake at 350 degrees. Remove from oven, cool cake for one hour.



Icing ingredients:

1 (16 ounce) package powdered sugar 1/3 cup cocoa 2 sticks of butter 1/4 cup milk 1 teaspoon vanilla extract 1 cup chopped nuts

Directions:

Sift sugar and cocoa together. Mix with melted butter. Add milk, vanilla, and nuts. Spread on cake.

Enjoy with a cold glass of milk! This cake freezes well.
